

Why a 25th Anniversary Campaign?

- ✚ It is to commemorate Good Shepherd's 25th anniversary as a congregation. In 1983 local Raleigh churches and the national church supported Good Shepherd as a mission church.
- ✚ God has blessed Good Shepherd and its ministry. This is a chance for us, the congregation, to give back in ways that will provide a major impact both locally and globally.
- ✚ This campaign is for celebrating Good Shepherd's 25th Anniversary and is focused on giving above and beyond our annual budget.

What are the focus areas for the 25th Anniversary Campaign?

In honor of the 25th Anniversary, the focus will be on Evangelism and Outreach. As well, Evangelism and Outreach advocate projects representing local and global applications.

Projects Listed in Priority Order

Support New Mission Church in Southeast Raleigh

- Funding will assist with rent, office space and publicity for the new church. The Synod will provide a pastor and some expenses, but the need for initial monthly financial assistance will be significant.

Fund a Habitat for Humanity Home

- Funding will be used for purchasing basic building materials for the home.
- Labor, to construct the home, will be provided by Good Shepherd and partner congregations, if needed.

Fund Three Pastoral Internships beginning in 2007

- Funding will provide basic living expenses and a stipend for a seminarian in their third year to spend 12 months of learning and preparation for a pastoral call.

Provide funding for PLM Families Together (formerly Pan Lutheran Ministries) Reserve Fund

- PLM Families Together provides housing and empowering support to homeless families so they may achieve self sufficiency. Funding would provide for a "reserve fund" that would be available during periods of reduced cash flow.

Provide furnishings for up to 1 Serving Cup apartment

- The Serving Cup ministry, sponsors of GSLC Coffeehouse, has been awarded a federal grant to fund construction of 6 apartments for adults with developmental delays and their caregivers.

Provide funding for WIHN, Wake Interfaith Hospitality Network, Needs

- An example of needs for WIHN is monthly City Bus Passes for families needing basic transportation.

Fund Mission trips to Mnene Parish and/or Costa Rica Lutheran Mission

- Funding will allow for GSLC members to travel to these opportunities and provide assistance in areas of greatest need.
- Funding will allow persons from the Mnene Parish to visit GSLC.

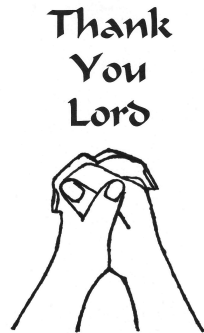

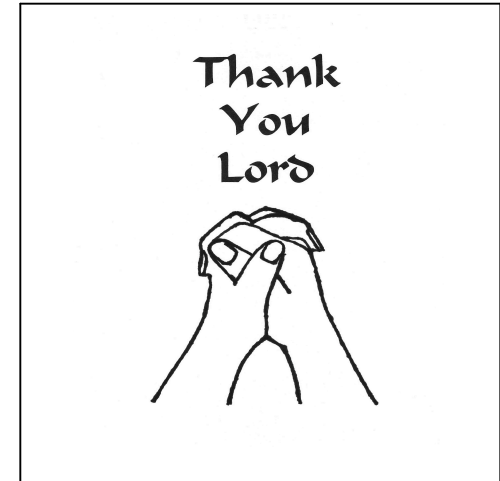
