Description:

Timing of Event:

- Pre-Event Planning: 3 hosts families
- Day of Event: 3 hosts families, 2-3 Supporting

Timing	Activity
3-4 weeks prior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hosts families selected and agree upon the dinner course • Promote event via GSLC Newsletter and Pewletter (go to GSLC website and post accordingly - must be submitted by Wednesday morning in order to be included in Sunday’s pewletter). Promote event to GSLC Facebook Group (administrator of this site will post entry – Contact Director of Faith Formation). • Reserve the church bus for the evening of the event if possible
1-2 weeks prior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create and hang signage on Wittenburg Wall to promote event • Youth Group Leaders begin discussing event with HS Youth to get them excited about the Event • Chaperones identified to assist with transportation
Day of event	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HS youth meet at church at 4:30 with required payment • Youth Leader will collect the money • Chaperones and youth depart at 5:00 for the 1st home hosting the Progressive dinner course (appetizers/salad/soup) • Chaperones and youth depart at 6:30 for the 2nd home hosting the Progressive dinner – (main course) • Chaperones and youth depart at 8:00 for the 3rd home hosting the Progressive dinner – (dessert) • Chaperones and youth depart at 9:30 and return to GSLC for pickup.
Following event	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth leader submits all money collected to the church for deposit in the Youth ministry Progressive Dinner account. • Host families submit expense receipts for reimbursement using the church reimbursement form and submit to DFF for approval and processing.
