¹ An additional yearly non-refundable classroom supply fee of \$20 (Transitional Kindergarten only) is to be paid at registration

Registration Fee is equal to one month's tuition and is non-refundable unless the family moves out of Raleigh by 8/1/11 and provides proof thereof.

Registration Fee is due and payable at registration (1/14/11), unless the family is enrolling 2 or more children at GSLP. If so, the family may pay 50% of the the total due at registration and the remaining balance by NO LATER THAN 3/4/11. If payment is not received, the family is subject to a \$25 late fee and loss of their children's placement in the program.
